### Rooibos Cream Orange

Rooibos blend with strawberry pieces and a delicate cream note.

### Afternoon Gold

Orthodox African tea, aromatic, medium-bodied with a slight spicy, nutty note.

### Princess Grey

Black tea with a refreshing citrus aroma of bergamot.

### Chai Ginger Orange

Fresh ginger with orange, blended with an Indian spice mixture, full and aromatic.

### Jasmine Pearls

Delicate hand-rolled tea leaves flavoured with fragrant jasmine flowers.

### Peach & Ginseng Oolong

Oolong tea flavoured with ginger and peach.

### Rooibos Chocolate

Full-bodied, aromatic Rooibos infusion with chocolate notes.

### Apple Crumble

Flavoured fruit infusion with a sweet baked apple character.

### Açai Goji Berries

Fruity infusion with the sweet, tangy taste of açai and goji berries.

### Refreshing Mint

Pure mint leaves with a crisp, cooling flavour.

Gentle floral infusion with calming notes of chamomile blossoms.
